



## Chairperson, Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering

The College of Engineering at Tennessee Technological University (TTU) invites nominations and applications for the position of Chairperson of the Electrical and Computer Engineering department.

**Required Qualifications:** Applicants must have a doctorate in electrical or computer engineering, or a closely related field. Sufficient teaching experience, scholarly accomplishments, and sustained externally funded research activities to qualify for an appointment to the rank of tenured full professor at TTU. Good interpersonal skills and ability to interact effectively with students, colleagues, staff and other on- and off-campus individuals. Ability to communicate effectively. Demonstrated good character, professional ethics, maturity of attitude, demonstrated teamwork characteristics and strong familiarity with relevant aspects of an ECE Department.

**Preferred Qualifications:** A BS degree in EE, CmpE or equivalent, administrative and management experience, non-academic professional or industrial experience, leadership experience, relevant accreditation activity experience, professional society and public service experience, and professional engineering registration are preferred.

**About the Department and the College:** The department of Electrical and Computer Engineering has 16 full-time faculty members and approximately 400 undergraduate and 60 graduate students. The Department offers undergraduate curricula that lead to Bachelor of Science degrees in Electrical Engineering and Computer Engineering. Graduate curricula that lead to Master of Science degrees in Electrical and Computing Engineering and the Doctor of Philosophy degrees in Engineering with specialization in Electrical and Computer Engineering are also offered. Three state-supported Centers of Excellence within the College of Engineering support and promote the research of faculty and graduate students.
