The successful applicant will be expected to teach the following courses: introduction to digital design (includes a lab using Altera devices and Quartus), a course in electrical engineering for civil engineering students (includes a lab), and the first course of a two course sequence in electronics.

A Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering is preferred, but applicants with an M.S. in Electrical Engineering and extensive teaching or industry experience will be considered. The start date is August 22, 2011.
