One-Year Instructor Position in Computer Science

The Department of Electrical Engineering & Computer Science invites applications for a one academic year instructor's position in the Computer Science program to begin August 2011. Outstanding candidates in all areas of Computer Science will be considered. This instructor will be teaching undergraduate classes in the Computer Science and Applied Computer Science programs and/or programming classes in the Electrical Engineering program. This instructor may also teach and oversee associated laboratory classes in the Computer Science and Applied Computer Science programs. Student mentoring and advising, participation in department-level service, and course and program level assessment activities for accreditation will also be required.

Minimum qualifications: Applicant must hold a bachelor's degree and a master's degree in Computer Science and at least one term of experience teaching at the college level.

Preferred qualifications: All CS specialties will be considered, but a background in programming and teaching introductory programming courses is preferred. Experience working and interacting with people from a variety of culturally diverse backgrounds is also preferred.

Northern Arizona University has a student population of about 25,000 at its main campus in Flagstaff and at about 30 sites across the state.
